Brief Description of cultural element	
The scythe reflects the traditional way of life. It is a family event when members of the family gather to harvest the wheat or barely.	
Material objects associated with the element	
The scythe is held in the hand and it is used to cut the wheat or barley. The harvest is then placed on the donkeys back to transport the straws from the field to the storage space.
